RELATE

READ AND REFLECT

- What sin did David first commit regarding Bathsheba? What was the result of that sin? (See 2 Samuel 11:2-5)
- What are some ways that teens “lust” after others today?
- David committed a second sin to try and cover the first. Which Commandment did he break now? (See 2 Samuel 11:14-17)
- What happened after Bathsheba found out about Uriah’s death? How did God feel about this?
- After Nathan confronts David about his sin, David repents. What consequences does David avoid? What consequences must he suffer?
- Why do you think God reserves sex for married couples?
- What are some of the consequences associated with committing adultery (sex outside of marriage) today?
