What was the result of Jonathan's words to his father? How do you think Jonathan felt as he confronted his father about David?

Mark 14:3-9

What did the people at the house think about the woman's actions?

How does Jesus respond to their comments?

What was so special about the woman's actions that merit Jesus' words in verse 9?
